He couldn't sleep all night and got up at the crack of dawn to go to his office. He was nervous as a cat all day, had lunch and watched the clock.

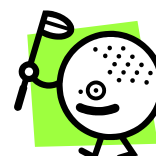
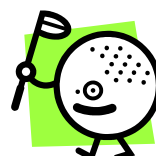
He figured if he could get by until midnight he would be okay.
