
Thanks Joe from all of your A1 team. You've watched us for many years now and are well and truly a part of our successes.

Government Grant

Kym Wenham, Secretary of the Echunga Golf Club received a cheque for \$11,000 from the Member for Heysen, Ms Isobel Redmond.

Echunga won the grant from the State Government Active Clubs Program and will be used to help with funding the installation of a computerised watering system on the back 9 of the club.

The Club is currently taking steps to ensure the watering of the course is as efficient as possible.

The installation of the computerised system will allow for watering to take place only when needed and at night when conditions ensure a minimum amount of evaporation takes place.

The recent purchase of the property adjacent to the course in order to increase its water storage ensures the course will be kept green even through the hottest summers.

Echunga is number 1 in Pennants

Echunga is the number one Pennant Team in the Southern Group for only the second time after winning the historic Von Doussa Shield beating the recent powerhouse of the Southern Group Willunga 4 ½ to 2 ½ in an exciting final at Victor Harbor.

Our only other win was way back in 1978 but since those days our top team has competed in the second division Our congratulations go to the team well captained by Trevor Huckel and comprising for the final John Norman, Mike Haslett, Matt Raven, Matt Hickman, Hara Taverna and Michael Wilson. Congratulations as well to Ian Bonython and Bill Guy who played in the team during the minor round. The focus of this group on achieving success is demonstrated by the fact that several of the players travelled to play at the away club in the week prior to away games just to give them the extra edge in these important matches.

Our away results were strong this year which was important in us grabbing a finals berth.

The genesis for the great win this year was winning the A2 Pennant in 2002 to finally gain promotion back up to A1.

Last year we finished a strong third to avoid relegation and this year our play was at another level throughout the minor round and again in the final to beat a strong Willunga team.

This win has certainly raised the profile of Echunga amongst the Southern Group so let's hope we can continue to be an A1 division contender in the future.

Gus Cooper was there at the last and brought the shield back to the clubhouse. I am told the members have never seen him walk so tall.

Gus said, "I was just so, so proud of the players. They played like those you see on TV. Wonderful stuff!"


