Bob joined the club in 1970 and was at the time of his passing, our 3<sup>rd</sup> longest serving member.

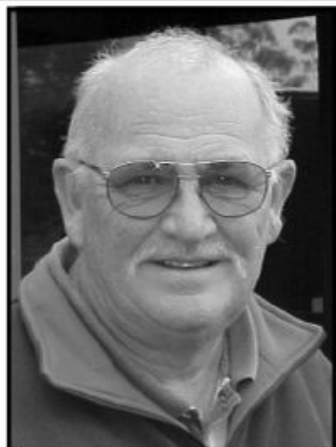
He served on the Management Committee for 5 years (2002 – 2007) including 4 years as Vice President.



We all returned to the clubrooms wet and cold for coffee and an early lunch. There was a raffle, but none of us won any prizes.

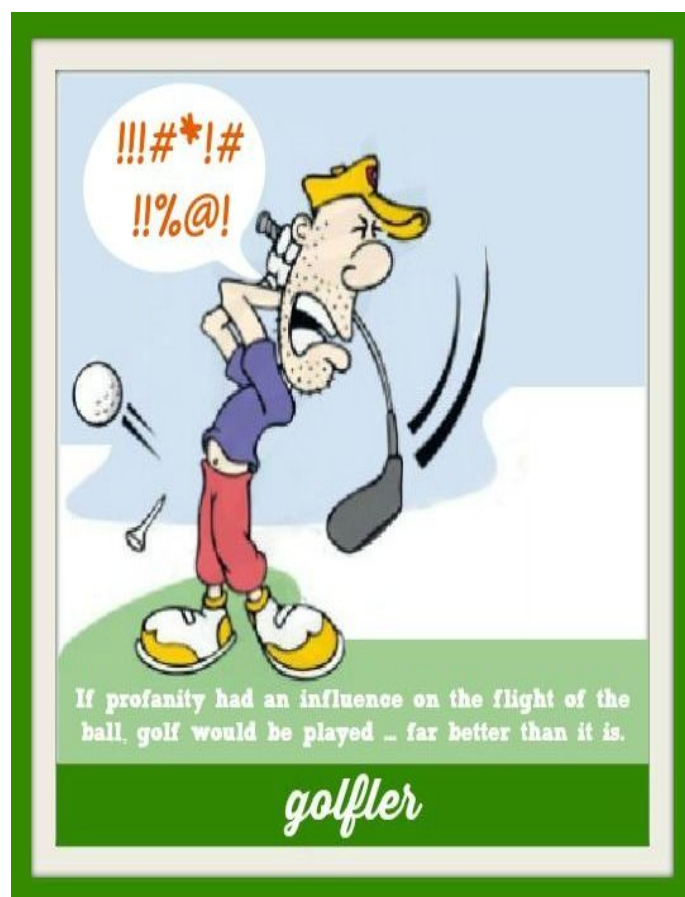
As so few holes had been played they decided to hold a lucky card draw for the golf prizes. All of us from Echunga won a prize so the day was not a total loss.
