## Message from the President

**Dear Members** 

On behalf of the committee I would like to thank members for their support during this time.

The course has been in exceptional condition and the committee is committed to maintaining its standard.

With the support of your membership good things can be achieved.

Over the past few weeks considerations around operating the club have been testing as conditions have changed rapidly.

The pandemic has and will continue to have an impact on our operations during the immediate future. The committee has been formulating plans to minimise the impact both on financial and course standard fronts.

Your support coupled with our strong position and commitment provides a basis to keep essential and effective operations going even in the event a Prolonged closure becomes inevitable.

The recent events which led to our decision to temporarily close the course are well documented. This has given time for us to consider options around re-opening the course to members without compromising our standards around community responsibility.

We are now pleased to advise you of our intent to re-open the course to members only for the time being and under adapted playing conditions.

It is essential these conditions are adhered to, in order that we can keep the course open, as long as we are able.

Timing around re-opening and conditions of play will be communicated in due course. Essentially, we will be moving towards a 2-person system of play while maintaining appropriate social distancing and hygiene practices.

It should be stressed the decision to play is a choice for members to make. There are a number within our membership whom are over 70 years of

age. We trust they are aware of health recommendations, as we should all be, to stay at home except for essential reasons including some measured approach to exercise and wellbeing.

Golf will be on the table after this has all passed.

We cannot say how long the course can remain open under the above conditions. Further restrictions including enforced closure may apply.

Notwithstanding we are substantially volunteer based we iterate our commitment to deal with any circumstance as it arrives to the best of our ability.

We look forward to your ongoing support and thank you in anticipation thereof.


