



Around the course Green Fees & Buggy Hire

Attention to all EGC members and green fee players.

Notice of Green Fee and Buggy Hire Increases.

The Committee advises that Green Fee and Buggy Hire costs have been reviewed and increases will take effect from Monday 5th October.

Green Fees and Buggy Hire charges have been kept at the same price for several years while Buggy costs and maintenance along with Course maintenance costs have increased.

We have attempted to keep the increases to a minimum to reflect our continuing commitment to provide real value for members and green fee players.

GREENS CORING

Due to the inclement weather on Monday the 23rd September, the process of coring the greens had to be cancelled.

Unfortunately, the alternative date that was scheduled for Thursday the 8th October has had to be changed again due to the weather, so hopefully the coring will now take place on Friday, 16th October.

This has created the need to change some of the dates of the Club Championship Rounds.

COMPETITION YOUCHERS

As a result of Corona Virus the expiry date for competition prize vouchers has been extended until 1st April 2021 for vouchers issued up to 1st October this year. This will apply to vouchers presented at the club and at Golf World.

Sponsors vouchers (eg Old Mill) are not affected.

CLUB ROOMS

The Club has secured a grant from the Federal Environment Department to assist with the installation of solar panels on the Clubhouse.

The grant of \$12,500 will be towards the total cost of \$15,400.

It is expected that this will save the Club up to \$10,000 in power bills per year.

The Committee has also approved the upgrading of the interior of the Club Rooms. New carpet and a fresh paint job will certainly lift the appearance of the Club Rooms which is overdue after 23 years.



"While out walking along the edge of a creek just outside of our house in Darwin, with my soon to be ex-husband discussing our property settlement,



This is what we, who are aged 70 or 80 years plus, can look forward to.

This is something that happened at an assisted living center. The people who lived there had small apartments but they all ate at a central cafeteria. One morning one of the residents didn't show up for breakfast so my wife went upstairs and knocked on his door to see if everything
