"Grand," replied the Irishman, "so pour the pints and start the clock."

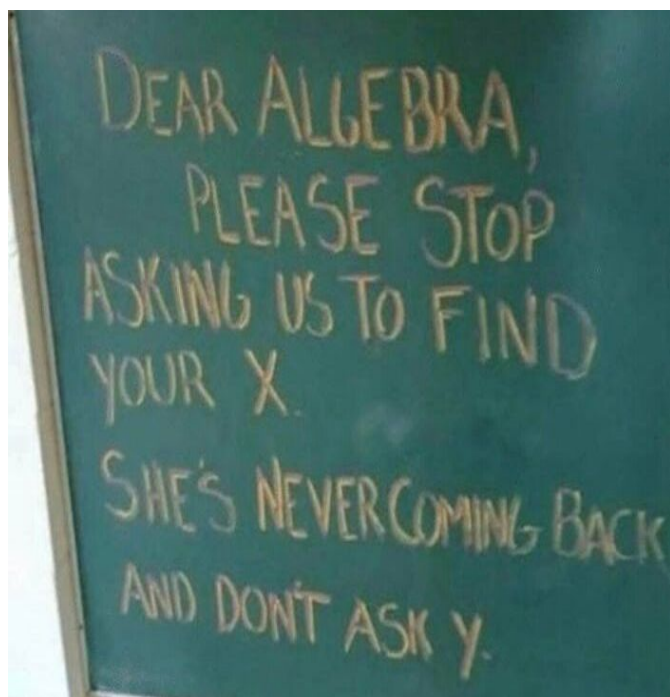
It was very close, but the last drop was consumed with 2 seconds to spare.
