VOLUNTEERS' REPORT

Fallen tree branches continue to keep us busy cutting them up and removing them from the course.

I guess it provides a steady source of firewood!

All tee block markers have been trimmed up and cleaned and I think that they are going to be painted to be more prominent.

A crew spent some time filling in divot marks on all fairways. Now that there are more sand bins around the course, how about filling in a few divot marks on each hole, as you walk to the next green!

The buggy wash bay is finished, with water connected and will provide a larger space to wash the mud off.

The sand bucket rack by the tank will be relocated, probably near the cross over to the 10th tee block.

A new sand bucket rack has been built on the outside of the BBQ area for greater convenience.

We do a lot of potting up of bushes and trees but we are light on big plastic pots 30 cm, 12 inches, in diameter and larger. If you have some that you do not want, could you leave them outside the buggy room please? Smaller ones would be great too.

Pennant update

Pennant Results round 4

Round 4 was a successful week for 2 of our teams. The B1 team had a good win down at Victor Harbor against Mt Compass, 4.5/2.5, and for the C2 team who won against South Lakes, 4/3, at South Lakes.

The B1 team was bolstered by new comer Jake Haynes and Naren Taverna who was returning, after a back strain injury kept him out of the A1 side last week. It was a solid performance all round that could easily have been 7-0, with all players leading their opponents with only a few holes to play. This result keeps them in the race for a finals berth, but they'll need to win in round 5 and hope another result goes their way too...

The C2 team has a very solid line up who each take their turn to win. They downed South Lakes on their own turf, and now find themselves in a commanding position with 2 wins, and a loss, and having had the bye already, they only need to win in round 5 to guarantee themselves a spot in the final.

The C1 and the A1 teams both had the opportunity to cement a finals berth in round 4 having won their first 3 games, but it was not to be and now both teams will need to perform well in the final round to make the finals.

The C1 team ventured out to Strathalbyn, to take on Oakbank who came armed with... Handicap! Our men had to give away 50 shots in total to their opponents. They battled it out bravely and had 3 good wins, including Alan Bailey's 3/2 win whilst having to give 11 shots to his opponent. They also had 3 matches that went to the last hole, resulting in narrow losses. Had 1 of those matches been a win or even a half they would have stitched up their finals appearance, but they fell just short, and now they will need to make amends next round with a win or a half...

The A1 team went in with a very strong side and with a bit of confidence against the highly rated Lady bay team, down at Mt Compass. Billy Cawthorne made his long awaited debut in the A1 team after making his club debut some 10 years ago playing in the Echunga junior team. Congrats to Billy for finally making it to the big time! 'Little Bill' faced off against Lady Bay's Jack Carter, under the watchful eye of skipper 'Big Bill' Guy who was playing in the same group in the number 2 spot. Little Bill had a half and Big Bill had a win (4 from 4 so far this year). A couple of our guys had bad days, whilst a couple of others ran into opposition who were having very good days, and so in the end we didn't get the result. We will need to bring our best into round 5, in what amounts to a preliminary final against Willunga, being played at Mt Barker!

2nd June 2021 (entries close 27/5/21)**

The Primary Schools Golf Event is for Boys & Girls in grade 5, 6 or 7 who are aged 10 years and over at 31st Dec 2021.

(Students who are in grade 4 and meet the above age criteria and have some experience playing golf may seek permission to participate from Golf Australia via email to: allant@golf.org.au)

The event has two sections (qualifying and state final). All students will compete in a 9-hole qualifying event on a shortened course.

Qualifying - Students to arrive from 9.00am > 9.30am unless otherwise advised.

9.30am - students will participate in a 90min skill session, followed by lunch then play, concluding by 2.30pm approx.

Participation Fee: \$10 paid at the venue on the day.

State Final - A maximum of 10 students with the lowest scores (including a minimum 2 girls) from each Golf District will qualify making a total of 160 for the State Final.

Day 1 – 15 holes and Day 2 – 18 holes.

Students who qualify to the State Final will be notified of their progression on the day of their qualifying event and provided details on how to register.

HOW TO REGISTER

- Players must register online into their correct District qualifier. Registrations close 7 days prior to each event.
- Register via the Golf Australia Website www.golf.org.au Click on the 'Events & Results' tab and under the 'Competitions' tab, select 'National events calendar'. Then select as the

location 'South Australia' and under category select '11. School Events'.

- Find your qualifier in the calendar and register.

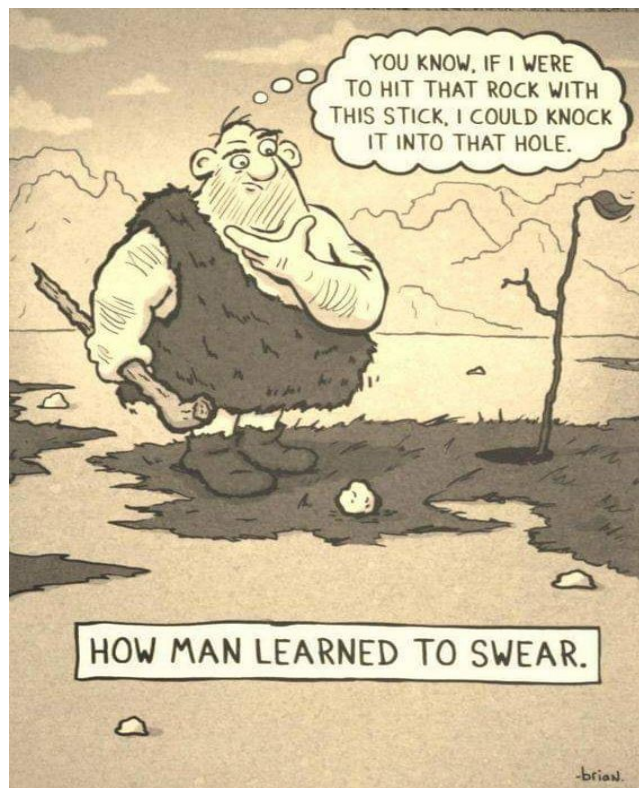
