
It's been a long time since we have had sand greens at Echunga, but by the scores on the 30th October, it was obvious that many players handled them well.

- A ball moved by enemy action may be replaced, or if lost or destoryed, a ball may be dropped not nearer the hole without penalty.
- A ball lying in a crater may be lifted and dropped not nearer the hole, preserving the line to the hole, without penalty.
- A player whose stroke is affected by the simultaneous explosion of a bomb may play another ball from the same place. Penalty one stroke.


