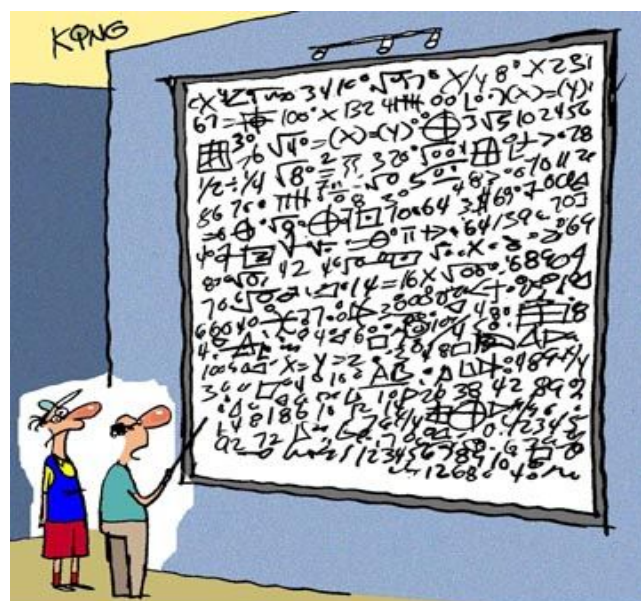

From the President

Club Lease At the end of July we were pleased to be able to sign off on the Lease Agreement with Council. This has been an ongoing exercise for almost three years and needed some fine tuning at the end. What we have agreed to with Council is that for the period of 21 years, the Echunga Golf Club will lease the course from Council for a peppercorn rental of \$1 per annum. In agreeing to

that arrangement, Council has required the club to provide a reviewed strategic plan every 5 years which demonstrates our Not for Profit status and an ongoing Community benefit.. Up until this year our arrangement with Council, was formalised through a Management agreement via the Echunga Recreation Grounds Committee and reviewed every 5 years. This new agreement provides a much stronger level of independence and security for the club and establishes a secure base from which the club can continue to grow. It took a long time to go through all the hoops and mazes. We can now proceed to work with Council and the Rec Board to establish formal agreements with respect to access to Waste Water which adds an important level of security to the whole community.

There are two things you can learn by stopping your backswing at the top and checking the position of your hands: how many hands you have, and which one is wearing the glove.

Hazards attract. Fairways repel.

You can put "draw" on the ball, you can put "fade" on the ball, but no golfer can put "straight" on the ball.

A ball you can see in the rough from 50 yards away is not yours.

If there is a ball in the fringe and a ball in the bunker, your ball is the one in the bunker

If both balls are in the bunker, yours is in the footprint.

Don't buy a putter until you've had a chance to throw it.
