As we have had a number of new members join in the past 12 months, so random draw groups will allow new friendships to be made.


The composition of the Management Committee has been resolved with the members who had their nomination ruled invalid at the AGM asked to fill the vacant positions.



The Australian Veterans Golfers Union National Championship 2023 Canberra

South Australia was represented by around 30 players at the Veterans Golf National Championship, held in Canberra in November. Players could participate by being a member of a Veteran's Golf Club and didn't necessarily have to be a top level golfer.

The first event was a 4BBB and my friend, Mabel, (from Mildura GC) and I played at Fairbairn GC. This was a mixed event and we were not in the winners

Tuesday was the first round of the 54 hole Stroke competition, held in conjunction with a daily Stableford competition. I played at Gold Creek with other groups playing simultaneously at the other two courses. Gold Creek was a long course with considerable distances between holes and having paths winding between houses and underneath roads.

The other courses also had these features.

I was in B grade and played off H/C 26 on this course, achieving 32 pts. (Nett 76)

Wednesday was a rest day for sightseeing, so Mabel and I visited the War Memorial, Mint and Lake Burley Griffin.

Thursday I played at Queanbeyan off H/C 29, scoring 31 pts (nett 77) and Friday at Gungahilin Lakes, playing off H/C 31and scoring 36pts (nett 72). This last course was obviously the most difficult and 15 of the holes had water in play.

My first hole required a significant carry over water and I was very relieved to make it!

I was hoping to win something in the daily Stableford competition, but it took a complaint from my playing partner, who pointed out my name had been omitted and it was then determined I had missed 3rd on a countback, so I got a ball!

On the Friday night a Presentation Dinner was held which was attended by about 300 people. I was so surprised to have my name called to be presented with the trophy for overall B grade nett. (There were 42 women in B grade).

I'm looking forward to next year when the competition is being held in South Australia in the Riverland.


