Hi Fellow Golfers!

First of all ONE big gripe!

Last week after being away and not playing for three Saturdays, it was inspiring to see the work our ground staff and volunteers have done and the major improvements they have made to our golf course.

I was however dismayed at the condition of the fairways and greens left by recent players. There were many divots marks left on fairways unfilled and pitch marks on greens not repaired.

These were mostly all fresh and many had been made by players that morning. I am disgusted that our members could leave the course in such a state.

I thought maybe I was overreacting in writing this piece, but then I received the following e-mail this week from another member.

"With the course in magnificent condition due to the great work of the clubs green keepers it was disappointing to play in the 9th group off the tee yesterday and find both fresh and not so fresh divots on all of the tee block. Our group used at least 2 buckets of sand on all tees, and fresh pitch marks on all of the greens (the most being 9 on the 11th green). Surely all of the 8 groups who teed off before us saw the same divots we did and could have made some effort to fix them."

It is your course, don't leave it for others to fix your damage!

On a more pleasant note, congratulation to our Foursomes winners, Bill & Mike and to the other teams of Randy & Ian, Billy & Brenton, Hara & Naren on their efforts in reaching the playoffs. Congratulation to Alan & Geoff, Ken & Stan on their efforts. Alan seems to be on a roll, also winning the Norwood Screen Print Trophy and also to Don Beams on winning the Neutrog Fertilisers Trophy.

Congratulations to the Women's Champion Val Nairn and R/up Lisa Gray. The reports indicate a close final. Well done! Congratulations also to Veronica Bowman who was victorious in the Silver Slaver final over Janet Petherick.

Captain's Report

On Saturday 27th April the finals for the Foursomes Championships were held.

In the Semi finals, Billy Cawthorne & Brenton Sims lost to Randy Jones & Ian Bonython 3 & 2 in their match, whilst Bill Guy & Mike Haslett defeated Hara & Naren Taverna on the 19th.

The final was then between the teams of Bill Guy & Mike Haslett against Randy Jones & Ian Bonython.

After a see-sawing start, which saw both teams hold early leads of one up, Bill and Mike won three straight holes from the 5th to the 7th, including a decisive birdie putt holed from just off the front of the 6th green when Randy and Ian were already on with a 12 foot birdie putt that they couldn't make.

This stretch of winning holes put Bill and Mike into a commanding lead and combined with some solid foursomes golf allowed them to steadily win more holes through the middle of the round and in the end resulted in a comfortable 6 & 4 victory. All in all a fine effort by both teams as the match was played in fantastic spirit and produced some excellent golf.

New touch screen & leader board

Those that have played over the last fortnight or so will have now seen the new leader board system and hopefully everyone is enjoying seeing results and live scores, even if those personal scores might not be as good as we would like. Also keep your eyes on this leader board for other important measures and updates.

Everyone also seems to have taken to the new touch screen to sign in and input scores however I would like to remind players of two things:

- (1) please input your scores for all of the standard Thursday and Saturday competitions you play. If they are not done it requires finding the card manually which is time consuming (and annoying) for those finalising the competitions in the afternoon.
- (2) although all scores are to be input into the computer you are still required to place your cards within the grade boxes as all winning scorecards will continue to be checked for completion and accuracy.

Scorecards

In relation to our scorecard players may have noticed that there has been a couple of slight changes, one being the alteration to having a single box for gross score, stroke score and putts, with these boxes not split for players and marker.

The scorecard is only required to contain the players name, scores and current handicap and as such any information around the marker is only for the markers benefit (e.g. to be used to confirm your score prior to signing your own card). I have noticed players still including both the players and markers final scores at the top of the card however this information is not needed and the card has been updated to a single box for gross / net / putting scores to simplify this.

New NTP

The Committee, and in particular our Treasurer Geoff Quirk who has been busily updating our various sponsorship arrangements, has recently been able to obtain sponsorship from the Hahndorf Old Mill. They have agreed to provide a two for one meal voucher which we have decided to use as a NTP prize, specifically a "NTP in 2" on the 10th hole

To try and ensure this is as even as possible there will be 2 NTPs each week with one for the A & B grades and one for the C & D grades, although this will be a standalone prize and won't also include the standard \$10 voucher. We are in the process of sourcing some more markers and expect this new NTP to be in place within the next 2-3 weeks so keeps your eye out for it!

Online bookings

The online booking system is still planned to come into action during winter, and when a date is set we will give the members plenty of notice as well as the general information on how it will work. The system will be accessed via a Members Login link on the club website which can be logged into via a "Member Number" (this will be the last 3 or 4 digits of your Golflink number) and password (default will be set up as your birthday - day / month - e.g. 1st January would be 0101).

Some further works needs to happen behind the scenes on making sure our club's computer system is working properly so it can correctly run the online booking system as well as finalising the policies around using this system. In the meantime there will be a new link on the club website within

the next fortnight which will allow players to access the system, update details, change passwords as well as use the booking sheet, although it will not be live until further notice.

Pennants

Finally, our pennant season is fast approaching with teams entered into the A1, A2, B1, B2 and C3 grades. Once again Matt Hickman is taking on the unenviable job of organising all these teams and players and I would encourage all players to provide Matt with as much assistance as possible.

Players are also reminded that during pennant matches you are an ambassador for the club and whilst the head to head format of matchplay can be very intense and competitive, this isn't an excuse for not meeting the normal etiquette expectations of the game of golf whilst also upholding the values of the Echunga Golf Club.


