Captain's Report

Club Championships

Our Club Championships qualifying games have now been run and the competition now moves into the matchplay phase so well done to those who have qualified and good luck during the head to head matchplay games. Matchplay is a fantastic format to play golf, as it adds an additional interesting component into your normal round of golf. However, I would like to remind players that whilst matchplay can be intense and competitive, all players must play fairly and within the rules of golf whilst ensuring they uphold the etiquette requisite within golf.

Slow play

Over the past fortnight I have heard a number of comments around slow play due to the length of rounds during our club championships qualification rounds. Whilst this slow play is caused by a number of factors (full fields, stroke play, long grass and pesky white flowers...) there are a number of things each player and group can do to try and alleviate the problem:

- 1. Always play a provisional ball if you believe your first short may be difficult to find.
- 2. Carefully watch every shot you play, no matter how bad. Do the same for each shot of other players in your group.
- 3. Play "ready" golf. Ignore honour and play whenever you are (a) ready and (b) safe to do so.
- 4. If you find yourself behind have the first 2 players in the group putt out and move to tee off.
- 5. Let other groups through but ensure this is done efficiently. A good rule of thumb for this is if you call a group through and you subsequently find the lost ball, continue playing the hole if the group called through has yet to reach you.

Finally it is also very important for other players to show tolerance. We have all been in groups that have a bad run of holes and lost balls which result in falling behind, sometimes through very little fault of their own. Being frustrated out on the course makes very little sense given it is unlikely to solve anything and unlikely to help your own game.

Eagles

We have had a few eagles over the past couple of months and I would like to remind players that if you have had an eagle make sure you clearly mark this on your card by circling the score and writing **EAGLE** boldly across the top of your card.

Online booking

It is great to see that the vast majority of members are now using the online booking system correctly as the number of bookings without playing have dropped substantially. However, this will continue to be monitored as we move towards our busy summer months.

Two tee system

I have had a number of questions around when the two tee system will be in place, even though this is clearly marked within the member handbook.... This system will be implemented directly after our Club Championships have finished. As such it will be important that members take time to check their bookings within the online booking system to ensure they know if they are booked off the first or the tenth.

Presentation Night

The annual presentation night is fast approaching and it would be fantastic to see more new faces as well as many trophy winners as possible attend this night. A list of trophy winners will be placed on the notice board and website for members to check if they have won anything during the year as it may have been many months ago. Tickets to the night will be sold from the bar in the coming weeks.

Out and About

Friday 13th September – Murray Bridge Classic (Stableford)

26th September – West Lakes – Stableford
