

We made a good start with three points on the first hole, then Val hit a beautiful drive over the water on the seventh, but that was our peak for the day. Nevertheless, we enjoyed the company and the course was in beautiful condition with lots of roll and very fast greens.

There were 15 clubs playing and the winning team came from Mount Osmond and North Adelaide with 51 points, a team from Grange came second with 50 points.

March 27th – Mt Barker/Hahndorf – Stableford

This day seemed as if it was mid- winter – it was freezing at the start of play and players were delighted to taste the Vili's mini quiches which were being handed out as we registered. We fielded three players – Libby, Mary and Wendy. The course was in very good condition, but balls which left the fairway ran for a very long way on the hard, bare dirt (as I discovered only too frequently). Spotters were at their normal places on the second (water hole par 3) and on the sixth they were kept busy, but one of them admitted (at Pennants later) that she had collected over a dozen good (lost) balls while waiting for groups!! The story of the day was the player who refused to take a penalty when her tee shot from the 7th landed on the little island just before the 6th green – instead she elected to take off shoes and socks and wade to the island to hit the ball – she received a couple of balls for her pains!!
