In summary Eric is a member who is very passionate about the club and makes an effort to do stuff around the club whether it be helping to coordinate events, be a part of pennant teams, or get involved in the business end of the club. Eric for example was a key member of the process which resulted in the successful EGC Lease with Mount Barker District Council. He practically owns the first Tee time on a Thursday and Saturday, often hitting off before full light. He always argues that the club is for the members and should have the interests of the members as a priority and that the club needs to be accessible to the 'ordinary member' and not elitist.
