2016 Rule Changes

With the new year now passed, the recent changes to the rules of golf are now in force.

We have the latest Rules of Golf books available at the club, so I urge all members to take a copy and keep it in their golf bag. A quick summary of these changes are:

1. Anchoring the putting stroke.

Players are no longer allowed to anchor their putter when making a stroke, either directly to their body or via creating an anchoring point with their forearm. The infographic to explain the permissible and outlawed swing types is included in this month's edition of the putter.

2. Distance measuring devices which include other functions not allowed

Under the rules (generally Smartphone's with access to wind conditions, compasses etc) can now be used provided the outlawed functions are not used.

3. Rule 18-2b has been adjusted to remove the unfair penalty where a player's ball moves after addressing it.

Now a one stroke penalty will only be incurred if the facts show that your actions have caused the ball to move.

4. Training aids continue to be banned for use during a round

But the penalty has moved from disqualification to initially only being a 2 stroke penalty. Subsequent breaches will still result in disqualification.

5. The last one won't see too much effect on club golfers with a change to the rules around disqualification for signing an incorrect card. Where the player would not reasonably be expected to know they breached a rule. This is directed towards tournaments where viewers may call in a rules breach.

2016 EDITION OF THE RULES OF GOLF: Anchoring the Club — Understanding Rule 14-1b



WHAT CHANGES?

The new entry—Rule 14-1b—prohibits strokes made with the club or a hand gripping the club held directly against the player's body or with a forearm held against the body to establish an anchor point that indirectly anchors the club.

WHAT THE RULE SAYS

NOTE 1:
The club is anchored "directly" when the player intentionally holds the club or a gripping hand in contact with any part of his body, except that the player may hold the club or a gripping hand against a hand or forearm.

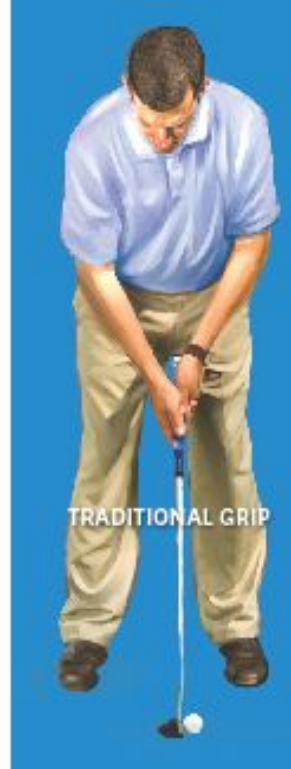
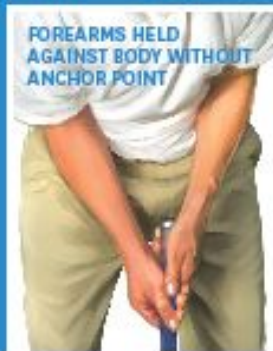
In making a stroke, the player must not anchor the club, either "directly" or by use of an "anchor point."

NOTE 2:

An "anchor point" exists when the player intentionally holds a forearm in contact with any part of his body to establish a gripping hand as a stable point around which the other hand may swing the club.

THIS IS NOT AN EQUIPMENT RULE — Conforming mid-length and long putters remain permissible provided they are not anchored.

Penalty
Anchoring the club in making a stroke brings a two-stroke penalty in stroke play and loss of hole in match play (as with any other breach of Rule 14-1).
