Captain's Report

What a busy time of year! I feel like I am only just coming up for air now as it's certainly been a hectic time since I came back from 3 weeks in NZ. Around the club we have seen the Club Championships finish up, our Mixed Foursomes were held, we had a great Presentation Night dinner and last week was the Ham and Turkey Day whilst Christmas is under a week away!

I would like to wish everyone a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year, hopefully with a combination of holidays and good weather we can all get out and enjoy lots of golf.

Permanent tee bookings:

The permanent bookings will be starting on Saturday 22nd December. These have been delayed for a number of reasons, however members need to understand that this is not a simple exercise as multiple groups want the same spots, particularly in the 7:20 am - 8:00 am time slots. This means that groups have been randomly drawn for these times and has unfortunately lead to the majority of groups receiving a permanent booking time of up to 3 slots before their earliest preference. With more groups than times available this is unavoidable.

The success of this system is also heavily reliant on members with permanent bookings removing their names from the sheet as soon as they are aware that they cannot play. The match committee will be checking this and players will lose their spots if this is not followed.

Practice fairway:

It has come to light that some members are under the misguided directive that our 9th hole also doubles as a practice fairway. This is certainly NOT the case and never has been. Whilst there are a number of reasons for this (safety concerns, ability for everyone to use it, wear and tear) the main one is that it breaches the rules of golf. The penalty for such a breach is disqualification from the competition.

The practice of hitting balls from the temporary hole area down into the scrub next to the 7th to warm up before play is also not allowed. Members are reminded that <u>ALL</u> practice beyond putting and short chips must only be done in the nets.


Lisa provided a lucky door prize (won by Rosie).


