CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - 2019

1. **ENTRIES** are limited and all entries will be recorded in order of receipt.
 - a. **All players must fill in a separate entry form.**
 - b. Entry is open to any player with an official Golf Australia handicap.
 - c. Entries close on **Thursday 28th February 2019**, unless fully booked earlier.
 - d. Entry within your preferred grouping is not confirmed or held until an individual entry form and payment is received from you.
2. **ENTRY FEES** are to be paid at the time of entry.
 - a. Entry fees will be returned if the number of entries received exceeds the available spots.
 - b. Refunds will be made for cancellations received by **Sunday 24th February 2019**.
 - c. Refunds for cancellations after this date will only be paid at the discretion of the Tournament Match Committee or upon receipt of a Medical Certificate.
 - d. Any applicable refunds will only be made after the completion of the Tournament.
3. **STARTING TIMES and HOLE ALLOCATIONS** will be posted on the club website late on **Friday 1st March 2018**.
 - a. **All PLAYERS** must sign in at least 20 minutes before their starting time.
4. The Rules of Golf, as adopted by The R&A will apply together with the Local Rules of the Echunga Golf Club.
 - a. Distance measuring devices, as allowed within The Rules of Golf may be used.
5. The **COMPETITION FORMAT** will involve 18 holes of stroke play for A and B Grade players and 18 holes of Stableford play for C Grade and female players. Handicap ranges for each grade will be determined after entries close.
6. **TIED RESULTS.** The gross event will be decided by a single-hole playoff. Players will play the 1st, 2nd & 9th until a winner is decided. All net events shall be decided using the standard count back system.
7. A player may win no more than one trophy daily, except in novelty events.
8. The MATCH COMMITTEE has the right to:
 - a. Refuse entry
 - b. Alter any event
 - c. Re-handicap any player and
 - d. Make any other alteration to the event it considers essential
9. Any **DISPUTE or PROTEST** must be made to the Match Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.
